

## Testing for Households

The Government has now introduced rapid lateral flow testing for families of Primary aged children to do at home. This is to check everyone in the household.

You can order a home test kit online for everyone in your household. (Do not order online if you can get a test through other methods. This frees up home delivery for those who need it most.) Details can be found here for ordering rapid lateral flow test kits:-

Please do not send your child to school if they have any of the following symptoms and we would ask that you notify us immediately if this is the case:

- **A Temperature of over 37.8 degrees**
- **A continuous cough**
- **Loss of taste/smell**

If your child displays these symptoms within school then you will be contacted to collect them and, while waiting, they will be placed into a separate area of the school.
