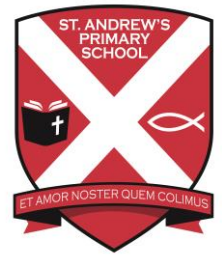

Your child is participating in weekly Forest School Session. The sessions take place within the school grounds, Tuesday afternoon – Acorn, Wednesday afternoon – Willow, Thursday afternoon – Maple and Oak.

Please ensure that your child has the following clothing:

- Outdoor Shoes – Walking boots or Wellingtons
- Warm Socks
- A Warm Coat – Preferably waterproof
- A Jumper or Fleece
- A T-shirt
- Trousers
- Waterproof over trousers if possible
- An extra layer of clothing depending on the weather
